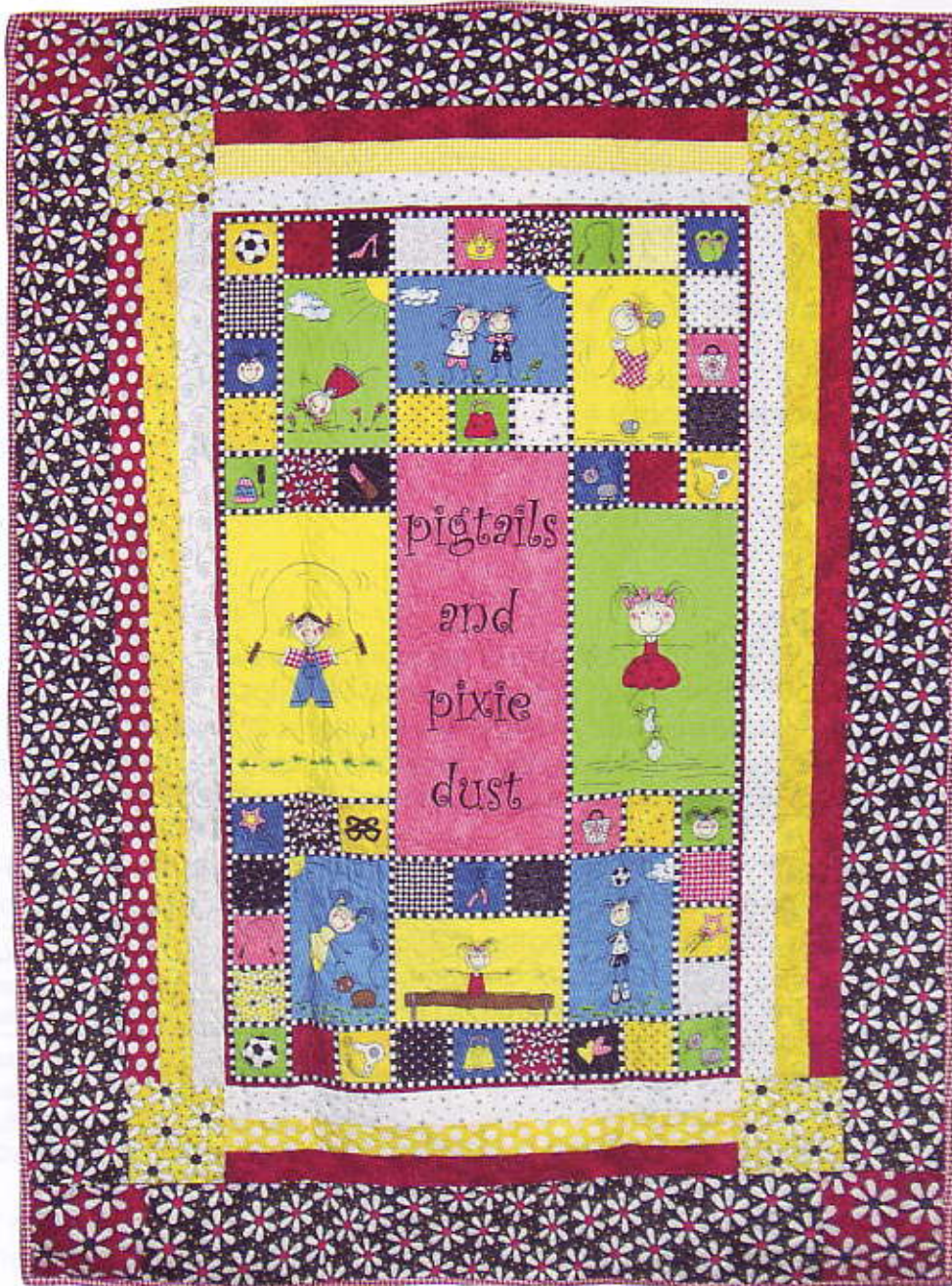

Fabric Cuts:

1 "Pigtails and Pixie Dust" Panel	- Troy Riverwoods #970		
1 yard black floral	- Troy Riverwoods #977-1		
¼ yard pink floral	- Troy Riverwoods #977-2		
¼ yard yellow floral	- Troy Riverwoods #977-3		
5/8 yard little plaid pink	- Troy Riverwoods #973-2		
¼ yard of white pixie dust	- Troy Riverwoods #975-3		
2 yards of girls things blocks	- Troy Riverwoods #971		
1/8 yard of each of the following fabrics:			
Little Dot White	- Troy Riverwoods #972-3	White Swirl	- Troy Riverwoods #976-2
Little Plaid Yellow	- Troy Riverwoods #973-3	Yellow Swirl	- Troy Riverwoods #976-1
Big Dot Yellow	- Troy Riverwoods #974-2	Pixie Dust Yellow	- Troy Riverwoods #975-1
Little Dot Pink	- Troy Riverwoods #972-1	Pink Swirl	- Troy Riverwoods #976-3
Big Dot Pink	- Troy Riverwoods #974-3	Pixie Dust Pink	- Troy Riverwoods #975-2
2 yards of 44/45" wide batting			

Quilt Construction:

1. Trim the panel to 23" x 38".
 2. Cut four – 5" squares of pink floral, and four – 5" squares of yellow floral.
 3. From the ¼ yard white pixie dust fabric, cut two 2" x 42/44" strips.
 4. From each of the 1/8 yard white, yellow and pink cuts, cut a 2" x 42/44" strip.
 5. Sew a white strip to a yellow strip, followed by a pink strip. Make 4 of these strip units. Mix up the fabric prints in each unit. For example – sew together a white pixie dust with a yellow little plaid and a pink swirl.
 6. Sew one of these units to the left side of the panel, white strip next to the panel. Follow with a unit to the right side of the panel, white strip next to the panel. Trim sides to square up.
 7. Trim the remaining 2 strip units to 23" in length each. Sew a yellow floral square to the left end of one unit, followed by a yellow floral square to the right end of the same unit. Sew a yellow floral square to the remaining unit, followed by the last yellow floral square to the right end of the same unit. Refer to the front picture as a guide.

8. Sew one strip/square unit to the top of the quilt, followed by the remaining strip/square unit to the bottom of the quilt. The white strips in the units should be next to the panel.
 9. Cut 2 strips from the black floral fabric, each one measuring 5" x 42/44". Sew the 2 strips together to make one long strip. Sew this strip to the left side of the quilt. Trim the excess even with the quilt top. Using the excess, and cutting another 5" x 42/44" strip of back floral, make a second long strip identical to the first one. Sew this strip to the right side of the quilt. Trim the side to square up the quilt.
 10. Cut 2 additional strips of black floral fabric, each measuring 2" x 33". Sew a pink floral square to the left end of one strip, followed by pink floral square to the right end of the same strip. Make a second strip in the same manner. Sew one unit to the top of the quilt, and one to the bottom.

11. Sandwich the quilt top, batting and backing together. Quilt as desired.
 12. Cut binding strips per your favorite method out of the 5/8 yard of little pink plaid. Bind the quilt to complete.
