## "Let It Snow"<sup>®</sup> Cuddle Quilt

56" x 72"

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## Materials Needed: Basic Sewing Supplies & Walking Foot

Center Panel: One "Let It Snow"© Panel #1080

First Border & Binding: 1 1/4 Yard Red Snowflake #1082/2

Blocks: Fat 1/8 Yards (Must be 9" X 21") Each Black Dots on Red #1083/3, Red Dots on Cream #1083/4 Aqua Dots on Brown 1083/1, Blue W/Gold Dots 1083/2, Cream Snowflakes 1082/1, Aqua Snowflake 1082/4, Black Snowflake 1082/5, Blue Snowflake 1082/3, Black Sprinkle 1081/7, Aqua Sprinkle 1081/6, Brown Sprinkle 1081/5, Red Sprinkle 1081/3, Green Sprinkle 1081/4, Blue Sprinkle 1081/2, Rectangles on Cream 1085/4 and Rectangles on Red 1085/1  
Fat 1/4 Yard Each: (Must be 18" X 21") Brown Rectangles 1085/3, Rectangles on Green 1085/2, Black Sleigh 1084/5, Cream Sleigh 1084/3, Green Sleigh 1084/2, Blue Sleigh 1084/1, Red Sleigh 1084/4

Backing: 4 Yards Cream Sprinkle Print # 1081/1

Batting: 3 Yards

### Instructions: DO NOT PRE-WASH FABRIC

1. Cut All Fabrics As Stated. WOF = Width of Fabric
2. 1/4" Seams are allowed on Panel and Building Blocks. 1/2" Seams are allowed for all connecting seams. Sew all 1/2" Seams "Up" or to the top side of the quilt. Press all seams. Clip all 1/2" seams every 1/4" to the sewn seam.

### Instructions:

1. Trim the "Let It Snow"© Panel to measure 21 1/2" X 35 1/2".
  2. From the Red Snowflake, Cut: Two 2 1/2" X 35 1/2" (First Border Sides)  
Two 3 1/2" X 25 1/2 Strips (First Border Top & Bottom) and Seven 2 1/2" X WOF Strips (Binding)
  3. From Each of the Six Sprinkles, Cut: Two 4 1/2" X 22 Strips  
From these Strips, Cut Eight 4 1/2" Squares
  4. From Each Fat 1/4, Cut: Six 2 3/4 X 22" Strips.  
From these Strips, Cut: Eight 2 3/4" X 9" Recs and Eight 2 3/4" X 4 1/2" Recs
- From Each Fat 1/8, Cut: Three 2 3/4" X 22" Strips  
From these Strips, Cut: Four 2 3/4" X 9" Rectangles and Four 2 3/4" X 4 1/2" Rectangles
- From the Backing, Cut: One 25" X 41" Rectangle and Forty Eight 9" Squares  
From the Batting, Cut: Forty Eight 8" Squares and One 24" X 40" Rectangle

### Building the Quilt

With right sides together, sew the 2 1/2" X 35 1/2" Red Snowflake Borders to the sides of the panel.

Press. Sew the 3 1/2" X 25 1/2" Red Snowflake Borders to the top and bottom.

This Center Section must measure 25" X 41". Adjust seams as needed.

Center the 24" X 40 batting rectangle on the wrong side of the 25" X 41" Backing Fabric. Place the panel on top. Baste all layers together using large stitches. Lay to the side.

Build each block by placing an 8" Batting Square on the wrong side of each 9" Cream Sprinkle Square.

Center a 4 1/2" Black Sprinkle Square on the top. Place Two 2 3/4" X 4 1/2" Blue Snowflake Rectangles right sides together, on opposite sides of the 4 1/2" Square. Sew in place. Open and press. Sew Two 2 3/4" X 9" Blue Snowflake Rectangles to the top and bottom. Press. Repeat this step to make Forty Eight Blocks. Refer to the cover photo for fabric placement.

Lay out the quilt as shown. Sew the blocks together in rows and then in sections sewing 1/2" Seams "UP" or to the top.

Sew the side sections to the sides of the panel section. Sew the top and bottom row sections onto the quilt.

Bind the quilt as desired. Clip all seams to the sewn seam every 1/4" Quilt the center panel.

Place the quilt in the washer and wash with cold water (No Detergent). Place in dryer and dry.

Remove all threads with tape and Enjoy!!
